

COMMISSIONERS' PROCEEDINGS
NIOBRARA COUNTY, WYOMING
July 3, 2000

The Niobrara County Commissioners met for their regular scheduled meeting on Monday, July 3, 2000 at 9:00 AM in the Commissioners' Room at the Niobrara County Courthouse. Present were Commissioners Richard L. James and Richard A Ladwig. Chairman Donna I Ruffing was not present.

Minutes of June 20, 2000 were approved as presented.

Receipts for the month of May from the Clerk of Court (\$327.85), and for the month of June from the County Clerk (\$2115.50) and Sheriff (\$935.00) were acknowledged.

The following business was addressed:

Old Hospital Sale – Kathryn Jensen presented the Commissioners with a check for \$18,500 and the Commissioners signed a deed transferring ownership of the old hospital to her.

Thunder Basin National Grasslands – Norm Wagoner, Forest Service Ranger from Douglas, WY, presented the Commissioners with copies of the comments received from the public concerning the draft proposed plan and Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) for the Thunder Basin National Grasslands.

Niobrara County Jail Facility – Brice Johnson representing Brice Refrigeration met with the Commissioners and Sheriff Reed. Mr. Johnson explained what had been done over the past year that his company has had the maintenance agreement on the heating and air condition system at the jail facility. He expects that the amount of maintenance needed for the next year will be less because of the extensive preventive maintenance program his company has been working on. As a result, Mr. Johnson submitted a proposal for the next year's maintenance contract that was \$693.00 below the previous year's contract. The proposal was taken under consideration and will be acted upon at the next scheduled meeting.

Liquor Permits – Applications for liquor permits for the 6th, 7th, and 8th of July at the fairgrounds during the Pageant of the Rawhide and for the 22nd of July for the Hytrek-Fiscus wedding from Lusk Liquors was approved. Application for a liquor permit for the 15th of July at the fairgrounds during the Alumni gathering from The Three Sister's was approved.
