

COMMISSIONERS' PROCEEDINGS
NIOBRARA COUNTY, WYOMING
June 20, 2000

The Niobrara county Commissioners reconvened their regular meeting on Tuesday, June 20, 2000 at 9:00 AM in the Commissioners' Room at the Niobrara County Courthouse. Present were Chairman Donna I. Ruffing and Commissioners Richard L. James and Richard A. Ladwig.

Minutes of June 6, 2000 were approved as presented.

The following business was addressed:

Budget - Annual departmental budgets for Facilities, Sheriff, Detention, Dispatch, Road & Bridge, Coroner and Mental Health were reviewed.

UPRR - The Commissioners met with Brad Holmes, representing Union Pacific Railroad, and County Attorney Doyle Davies. An Easement Purchase Agreement for county property was approved and signed. \$500 of the total purchase price of \$1,569 was received.

CDBG - Resolution 00-05 was approved and signed. The resolution supports application for a Community Development Block Grant Imminent Threat Grant in the amount of \$85,000 on behalf of the Niobrara Electric Association, Inc.

Library - Jeri Hineman was appointed to an additional three (3) year term on the Library Board, effective July 1, 2000.

Scholarship - The County Commissioners' Renewal Scholarship for the 2000-2001 school term was awarded to Magan Thayer.

Surety Bond - A Surety Bond for Michelle J. Proulx, Clerk/Treasurer for the Town of Lusk was approved and signed.

VOCA - The Crime Victims contract with Wyoming Victim Services for \$14,700 was approved and signed.

Other - *Brenda Vance met with the Commissioners regarding hospital/clinic issues. *The annual letter of support for the Niobrara Senior Citizens Center was approved and signed.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
