

COMMISSIONERS' PROCEEDINGS
NIOBRARA COUNTY, WYOMING
March 28, 2000

The Niobrara County Commissioners reconvened their regular meeting at 2:00 PM on Tuesday, March 28, 2000 in the Commissioners' Room at the Niobrara County Courthouse. Present were Chairman Donna I. Ruffing, Commissioners Richard L. James and Richard A. Ladwig and Secretary Billie Backhaus.

The meeting recessed for a Public Hearing.

A Public Hearing for the purpose of soliciting comments on the proposed RULES OF PRACTICE AND PROCEDURES FOR APPEALS BEFORE THE NIOBRARA COUNTY BOARD OF EQUALIZATION INVOLVING TAXATION MATTERS was called to order at 2:05 PM in the Commissioners Room at the Niobrara County Courthouse. Present were County Commission Chairman Donna I. Ruffing, Commissioners Richard L. James and Richard A. Ladwig, County Assessor Elaine Griffith and Secretary Billie Backhaus.

Griffith reported that she had received one request for a copy of the proposed rules and had furnished same. She also reviewed with the Commissioners changes recommended by County Attorney Doyle Davies per Wyoming statutes.


