

COMMISSIONERS' PROCEEDINGS
NIOBRARA COUNTY, WYOMING
November 21, 2000

The Niobrara County Commissioners reconvened their regularly scheduled meeting on Tuesday, November 21, 2000 at 1:00 p.m. in the Commissioners' Room at the Niobrara County Courthouse. Present were Chairman Donna I. Ruffing and Commissioners Richard L. James and Richard A. Ladwig.

Minutes of the November 8, 2000 meeting were approved as presented.

The following business was conducted:

Library Board - Reappointed Wanda Lorenzen to a 3-year term, retroactive to July 1, 2000.

ADA Compliance Officer - Appointed Becky Freeman, Deputy County Clerk, as Niobrara County's ADA Compliance Officer. Duties include receiving any and all complaints on non-compliance.

Drug and Alcohol Coordinator - Appointed Becky Freeman, Deputy County Clerk, as Niobrara County's Drug and Alcohol Coordinator. Duties include arranging periodic testing of Road & Bridge employees and maintaining records.

Assessor - Authorized Elaine Griffith to negotiate the sale of the county mapping to an interested party and to purchase a CD writer.

County Attorney - Had further discussion with County Attorney Davies on potential changes to the Niobrara Land Title Branch lease. Reviewed a Resolution signed by County Commissioners on March 5, 1991 "Imposing an Emergency Telephone Charge" for one calendar year. The resolution has never been renewed, however the charge has continued to be collected from all telephone subscribers within the County. No action was taken.

The meeting recessed at 4:00 p.m. for the Road Indexing Public Hearing to meet with landowners in the southeast quadrant to obtain easements on county roads.

The meeting reconvened at 5:00 p.m.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned.


