Assessor - Met with Elaine Griffith, County Assessor, to discuss two major tax reductions due to audits. Also discussed Department of Revenue Policy & Procedures.


Public Health - Accepted revisions to the Public Health Advisory Board By-Laws.

Taxes - Approved Tax Cancellation Order #00649 to Gary Anderson for \$155.86.


