The Niobrara County Commissioners met Monday, September 18, 2000 at 8:00 a.m. at the Niobrara County Courthouse for a scheduled brief meeting to conduct any urgent business. Present were Chairman Donna I. Ruffing and Commissioners Richard L. James and Richard A. Ladwig.

Minutes of the September 5, 2000 meeting were approved as presented.

Receipts for the month of August from the Justice of the Peace (\$1,425.00) and the Clerk of Court (\$376.65) were acknowledged.

The following business was conducted:

Greenbelt Project - Acknowledged a letter from WYDOT extending the grant to September 30, 2001.

Emergency Management - Acknowledged the County's share (\$2,412.83 plus installation) for the generator to be placed at the fairgrounds.


Grasshoppers - Reviewed a scoping request from APHIS for an environmental impact study on the control of grasshoppers and mormon crickets. Additional information will be forthcoming.

Liquor Permit - Approved a liquor permit for 3 Sisters on September 28, 2000 at the fairgrounds for the Wyo Rural Electric Assoc banquet.



Personnel - Presented a certificate of appreciation to County Clerk Suzanne Sturman from the Bureau of Census for her assistance.
