

COMMISSIONERS' PROCEEDINGS
NIOBRARA COUNTY, WYOMING
April 17, 2001

The Niobrara County Commissioners reconvened their regular meeting on Tuesday, April 17, 2001 at 9:00 a.m. in the Commissioners' Room at the Niobrara County Courthouse. Present were Chairman Donna I. Ruffing and Commissioners Richard L. James and Richard A. Ladwig.

Minutes of the April 3, 2001 meeting were approved as presented.

Receipts from the Clerk of Court (\$329.07) and Justice Court for the month of March were acknowledged.

The following business was conducted:

Executive Session - The meeting recessed at 9:05 a.m. for personnel matters and reconvened at 10:45 a.m.

Road & Bridge - Ratified the financial agreement with Baystone Financial Group for the purchase of two (2) new All-American Rollers (packers) at \$9,250 each. The agreement provided for \$6,676.01 as a down payment; \$6,676.01 to be paid April 9, 2002 and \$6,676.01 to be paid April 9, 2003.

Ratified the financial agreement with Rose Bros., for the purchase of a used Versatile 276 II tractor. The agreement provided for \$13,000 as a down payment; \$8,250 to be paid on August 1, 2001, 2002 and 2003.

Energy Options - Selected Wyoming Community Gas as the provider for 2001-02 at a fixed rate of 74.7.

Senior Center - Approved and signed letters of support for the next fiscal year.

Other - Authorized a letter of support for Terry Browder who has been recommended to the Governor to serve on the Carbon Sequestration Advisory Board.

Public Hearing - The meeting recessed at 4:00 p.m. for the final Road Indexing Public Hearing and reconvened at 5:15 p.m.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
