

COMMISSIONERS' PROCEEDINGS  
NIOBRARA COUNTY, WYOMING  
June 19, 2001

The Niobrara County Commissioners reconvened their regular meeting on Tuesday, June 19, 2001 at 9:00 a.m. in the Commissioners' Room at the Niobrara County Courthouse. Present were Chairman Donna I. Ruffing and Commissioners Richard L. James and Richard A. Ladwig.

Minutes of the June 5, 2001 meeting were approved as presented.

Receipts from the Clerk of Court (\$200) for the month of May were acknowledged.

The following business was conducted:

Juvenile Justice Task Force - Linda Brandt-Morton and Nancy Seely from Eastern Wyoming Mental Health presented a proposal to provide services to "at risk" juveniles as a part of the Title V grant funds. Donna Messerli, WCCA, delivered the application form for Title V funds. A workshop will be held in Casper on July 19th.

Public Hearing - The meeting recessed at 11:00 a.m. for the CDBG Stagecoach Museum grant application. The meeting reconvened at 11:25 p.m.

Resolution 01-05 - Following discussion, James moved, seconded by Ladwig, to approve application for funds from the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) for the purpose of ADA renovations. MOTION CARRIED.

911 Recorder Repair - Acknowledged a contribution of \$697 from the Town of Lusk.

Bonds - Approved the following bonds: Fred Mastriona/Hospital District Treasurer for 2000-01 and 2001-02; Richard Luchsinger/Superintendent of Niobrara County School District #1 and Goshen County School District #6; Michelle J. Proulx/Clerk-Treasurer Town of Lusk; and Penny Ven John/Deputy Clerk Town of Lusk.

Assessment - Acknowledged the Assessor's 2001 local assessment of 14,086,964 (an increase of 747,577) and the State assessment of 25,755,963 (an increase of 8,232,488). Total assessment 39,842,927 (a 29% increase of 8,980,065).

WIC - Approved and signed the 2001-02 Women & Infant Children's contract for \$1,815 for operations only.

Public Health Nurse - Regretfully accepted Brenda Pfister's resignation, tentatively effective July 31, 2001.


