

**COMMISSIONERS' PROCEEDINGS
NIOBRARA COUNTY, WYOMING
January 18, 2005**

The Niobrara County Commissioners reconvened for their regularly scheduled meeting on January 18, 2005 at 9:00 a.m. in the Commissioners' Room of the Niobrara County Courthouse. Present were Chairman Tom L. Wasserburger, Commissioners Richard A. Ladwig, Ronson B. Pfister and County Clerk Becky L. Freeman.

Acknowledged the following receipts for the month of December from the Clerk of Court for \$434.48.

Ladwig moved, seconded by Pfister, to approve the minutes of the January 4, 2005 regular meeting. **MOTION CARRIED.**

The following business was conducted:

Road & Bridge- Met with Road and Bridge Foreman Fred Thomas and discussed roads, equipment, county road funds and projects, and pit permits. Thomas advised the board that signs indicating sharp curves on Silver Springs Road had been installed and the permit for the Thomson pit had been submitted to DEQ. Wasserburger stated that Weed & Pest had inquired as to whether or not Road & Bridge would be able to move more dirt from behind their new building. Thomas stated it depended on when they wanted it moved and how busy Road & Bridge would be with road maintenance.

County Attorney- Met with County Attorney Doyle J. Davies and discussed old business. Davies presented the commissioners with a notice of claim from Qwest's attorneys, Hickey & Mackey, regarding the damage that was done to the phone lines that occurred during construction of the Silver Springs Road Project. Davies stated that copies of the notice should be submitted to Niobrara County's insurance providers.

Spotlighting Counties- The commissioners compiled information about Niobrara County, which will be read on the floor of the legislature by Representative Ross Diercks. Each county's legislator will be afforded 5-10 minutes to read the information and introduce any elected officials from Niobrara County that are present during this time.

WCCA Board- Pfister moved, seconded by Wasserburger, to reappoint Richard A. Ladwig as the Board Member to the Wyoming County Commissioners Association. **MOTION CARRIED.**

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 11:50 a.m. The next meeting will be held February 1, 2005 in the Commissioners room of the Niobrara County Courthouse.
