

COMMISSIONERS' PROCEEDINGS
NIOBRARA COUNTY, WYOMING
February 3, 2009

The Niobrara County Commissioners' Meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m. on February 3, 2009 in the Commissioners' Room of the Niobrara County Courthouse. Those in attendance were Chairman Richard A. Ladwig, Commissioners Arlene Zerbst Rapp, Greg Starck, and County Clerk Becky L. Freeman.

Road & Bridge- Foreman Fred Thomas met with the Commissioners and discussed road damage that was done on approximately seven (7) miles of North Mahnke Road by a private citizen plowing the road.

Ladwig discussed a phone conversation he had with WYDOT Resident Engineer Jim Barnes regarding roto mill that will be available to the county from WYDOT's resurfacing projects.

Hospital Board-Hospital District Board members Mel ZumBrunnen, Gene Kupke, and Hospital Administrator Bob Brummond, met with the Commissioners to discuss the allocations of the O & M funds from the 2002 1% Specific Purpose Excise Tax. They also discussed appointing a public health officer for Niobrara County.

County Attorney- Doyle Davies met with the Commissioners and discussed county business.

Elected Officials and Department Heads- Debbie Sturman, Elaine Griffith, Linda Fosher, Rick Zerbe, Becky Freeman and Denise Smith met with the Commissioners to discuss office operations.

Sturman discussed the old termite damage to the library. Griffith and Fosher both discussed program updates that will most likely be occurring in their offices and Zerbe discussed the storage building.

The Commissioners acknowledged receipts for the month of January from the County Clerk for \$2,573.75; from the Sheriff for \$14,135.48; and from the Clerk of Court for \$644.90.

Official Bond and Oath- Starck moved, seconded by Zerbst Rapp, to approve the Official Bond and Oath for Pamela Parmely as Treasurer for the Town of Manville. **MOTION CARRIED.**

Wyoming Dept. of Revenue- The Commissioners acknowledged three (3) Notice of Valuation Changes in the matter of the assessments of Medicine Bow Operating Company, # 2009-0083, for tax year 2007, El Paso E & P Company, LP., # 2009-0090, for tax year 2007, and for Harry L. Krejci, # 2009-0176, for tax year 2006. These valuation changes result in increases of \$59.05, \$270.71, and \$861.87 respectively.

Petition of Affidavit for Cancellation of Taxes- The Commissioners acknowledged a petition of affidavit for cancellation of taxes for Harry L. Krejci for \$861.87, cancellation #738. This cancellation is done to cancel the supplement set forth on the Wyoming Department of Revenue Notice of Valuation Change 2009-1076.

The Commissioners acknowledged receipt of a Memorandum from the Wyoming Department of Health concerning Title 25 recommendations.
