

COUNTY COMMISSIONERS' MEETING
NIOBRARA COUNTY, WYOMING
DECEMBER 7, 2011

The Niobrara County Commissioners' meeting was called to order on December 7, 2011 at 9:00 a.m. Those in attendance were Chairman Richard A. Ladwig, Commissioners Arlene Zerbst Rapp, Greg B. Starck, and County Clerk Becky L. Freeman.

Chairman Ladwig adjourned the regular meeting to conduct a public hearing on the renewal of retail liquor licenses for The Pronghorn Bar and Paleo Park. Clerk Freeman stated that all paperwork was in order. There were no other comments in favor of or in opposition to the renewals. Chairman Ladwig adjourned the public hearing at 9:05 a.m.

Retail Liquor License Renewals- Commissioner Starck moved, seconded by Chairman Ladwig, to approve the application for the renewal of a retail liquor license for Rex F. Groves D/B/A The Pronghorn Bar. MOTION CARRIED.

Commissioner Starck moved, seconded by Chairman Ladwig, to approve the application for the renewal of a retail liquor license for Kristen Stauffer D/B/A Paleo Park. MOTION CARRIED. Zerbst Rapp abstained from voting.

Chairman Ladwig adjourned the regular meeting to conduct a public hearing on setting Civil Processing Fees. There were no comments in favor of or in opposition to the fee change. Chairman Ladwig adjourned the public hearing at 9:15 a.m.

RESOLUTION 11-08- Commissioner Starck moved, seconded by Commissioner Zerbst Rapp, to approve the following resolution:

RESOLUTION NO. 11-08
SETTING CIVIL PROCESS FEES

WHEREAS the Board of County Commissioners may increase civil process fees not to exceed \$50.00 effective July 1, 2011 pursuant to W.S. § 18-3-608 (a) that was amended at Chapter No. 132 of the 2011 Session Laws;

WHEREAS the Clerk published Notice of the Hearing on November 30, 2011 at 9:00 A.M. in the Niobrara County Commissioner's Room in the Courthouse in Lusk, WY to accept written and oral comments upon whether or not to increase civil process fees from \$35.00 up to \$50.00;

WHEREAS there were no written or oral comments of objections.

IT IS THERE FORE RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners in and for Niobrara County, Wyoming that:

1. For the serving of process according to the Wyoming Rules of Civil Procedure, the county sheriff shall receive from the party requesting service, a single fee, paid in advance to be credited to the county general fund, in the amount of fifty dollars (\$50.00) for the first three (3) attempts at service at a different time and date for each attempt.
2. Thereafter a fee amounting to ten dollars (\$10.00) shall be charged for each succeeding attempt.
3. The court may waive the fees upon an adequate showing of indigency. Any fees waived may, pursuant to court order, be assessed and collected against any judgment rendered.
4. The county sheriff shall receive from the party for whom service is rendered in civil cases other fees which shall be transmitted to the county treasurer to be credited to the county general fund and which shall be paid in advance if demanded by the sheriff from the party for whom the service is rendered pursuant to W.S. 18-3-608 (a) and (b).
