

NIOBRARA COUNTY COMMISSIONERS' MEETING
NIOBRARA COUNTY, WYOMING

November 6, 2014

The Niobrara County Commissioners' meeting was called to order on November 6, 2014 at 9:00 a.m. Those in attendance were Chairman Richard A. Ladwig, Commissioner Greg B. Starck, and County Clerk Becky L. Freeman. Commissioner Arlene Zerbst Rapp was absent due to an illness.

Road and Bridge- Dave Thomson met with the Commissioners and Road and Bridge Foreman Fred Thomas to inquire if there were any plans to put some gravel on K Field road. He said there is more traffic on that road than there used to be. He also made the offer to the County to use his pit or the creek bottom for rock. He will furnish sand and gravel if we will put it on the road.

Fred then updated the Commissioners on road and bridge issues.

County Attorney- County Attorney Doyle J. Davies met with the Commissioners and discussed county business.

Consent agenda- Greg moved to approve the Consent Agenda. Richard seconded, motion carried. Items included on the consent agenda were Minutes of the October 21, 2014 and an official bond and oath for Keri Thompson as Treasurer of Niobrara County.

Malt Beverage Permit- Greg moved to approve a 24-hour malt beverage permit for the Wyoming Women's Center's Christmas Party being held at the fairgrounds on December 12, 2014. Richard seconded, motion carried. Greg moved to approve a 24-hour malt beverage permit for The Pavone Family Christmas Party being held at the fairgrounds on December 18, 2014. Richard seconded, motion carried.

E-911 System- Deputy Sheriff Kelly Dean met with the Commissioners and presented information from two vendors for the E-911 System. Kelly told the Commissioners that they preferred the Vesta 4- Airbus package as opposed to the Experient-Grabar package. The Commissioners took this under advisement.

Elected Officials & Dept. Heads—The Elected Officials and Department Heads met with the Commissioners and discussed office operations and county business.

Emergency Mgmt Coordinator- The Commissioners acknowledged receipt of Kester Aker's official letter of resignation as Niobrara County's Emergency Management Coordinator effective as of October 7, 2014.

Upon the recommendation of the sheriff's department, Greg moved to authorize the Sheriff to enter into an agreement with Vesta 4/Airbus for the purchase of a new E- 911 system to replace the existing 911 system which has reached its "end of life." Richard seconded, motion carried.
