

NIOBRARA COUNTY COMMISSIONERS' MEETING
NIOBRARA COUNTY, WYOMING

January 19, 2016

The Niobrara County Commissioners' meeting was called to order at 9:00 a.m. on January 19, 2016 at 9:00 a.m. Those in attendance were Chairman Richard A. Ladwig, Vice-Chair Greg B. Starck, Commissioner Patrick H. Wade and County Clerk Becky L. Freeman.

Road & Bridge – Foreman Fred Thomas met with the Commissioners and discussed road and bridge business.

Consent Agenda- Greg moved to approve the consent agenda. Pat seconded, motion carried. Items included on the consent agenda were the minutes of the January 5, 2016 meeting and an official bond and oath for Louis Hammer as Treasurer of the Niobrara Senior Citizen's Service District and receipts for the month of December from the Clerk of District Court for \$313.70.

Reallocation of Consensus Block Application Funds- The Niobrara Conservation District submitted a request for the reallocation of SLIB funds from the berm project (to protect the property at 208 Griffith Blvd. following the flood) to establishing a windbreak and landscaping at the new district building located at the business park. The amount being reallocated is \$5,000 and does not decrease or increase the amount of funding the district was originally awarded. Pat moved to approve the reallocation request. Greg seconded, motion carried.

Catering Permit- Greg moved to approve a 24-Hour Catering Permit for The Silver Dollar Bar to sell alcoholic beverages at the Sportsman's Banquet being held February 6, 2016 at the Niobrara County Fairgrounds. Pat seconded, motion carried.

County Attorney- County Attorney Cally Lund met with the Commissioners to discuss county business and possible upcoming criminal jury trials. Richard then inquired about the status of the Manville Spur paperwork.

Executive Session- Pat moved to enter into Executive Session with Attorney Lund at 11:10 to discuss personnel matters. Greg seconded, motion carried.

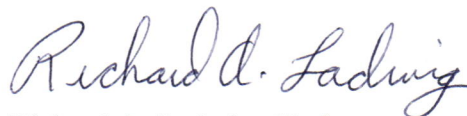
Greg moved to reconvene the regular session at 11:15 a.m. Pat seconded, motion carried. No action was taken.

The regular meeting reconvened at 3:00 p.m.

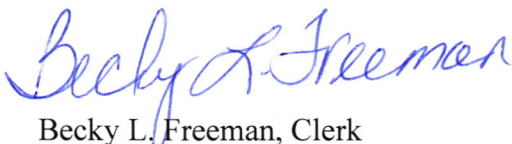
There being no further business, the meeting adjourned.
