

**RESOLUTION 02-03**

**911 ENHANCED SURCHARGE**

**WHEREAS**, in March 1991 the Niobrara County Commissioners approved a Resolution, to be in effect for one (1) year, authorizing "telephone service suppliers to collect the emergency telephone charge" of fifty cents (\$.50) per month on each access line, pursuant to Wyoming Statutes 16-9-101 et seq; and

**WHEREAS**, on January 2, 2001, after duly publishing notice and conducting a public hearing, the Niobrara County Commissioners authorized the continuance of the collection of fifty cents (\$.50) per month on each access line by adopting RESOLUTION 01-03; and

**WHEREAS**, Wyoming Statutes 16-9-101 et seq requires the annual reauthorization of the said collection.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the telephone service suppliers are hereby authorized to continue the collection of fifty cents (\$.50) per month on each access line in Niobrara County.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that said telephone service suppliers are hereby directed to remit said collections to the Niobrara County Treasurer.
