

**RESOLUTION 03-05**

**HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN**

**WHEREAS**, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) and the Wyoming Emergency Management Agency (WEMA) have required all Counties to develop hazard mitigation plans to be eligible for disaster declaration funds; and

**WHEREAS**, a Planning Team was formed to assess and prioritize the natural and man-made hazards which may affect Niobrara County; and

**WHEREAS**, said Planning Team developed strategies to mitigate the risks and determined needs to adequately respond to actual events; and

**WHEREAS**, two public hearings were conducted to present the Planning Team's findings and to receive public comments and input.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Niobrara County Commissioners do, hereby, approve and adopt the Hazard Mitigation Plan, dated January 31, 2003 and direct the plan be forwarded to WEMA for consideration.
