Chairman York called the meeting to order at 5:04 pm. Tadewald made a motion to approve the previously emailed minutes from the last meeting. Motion was seconded and carried. Wick made a motion to approve the previously emailed bill list and financial statement. Motion was seconded and carried.

Reports

Aerial Services Report: Boldon reported that from July 1, 2024, to April 7, 2025 we had been billed for 163 hours. Shannon and Dale reported they had flown approximately 18.3 hours from last billing to this meeting which totals 181.4 hours flown so far. Boldon was just letting everyone know where they were at on their contract allotment of 200 hours to June 30, 2025. York said we would vote on adding more hours to the contract at the May meeting.

County Trappers Report: John reported that there are four producers seeing coyotes and one producer is losing some calves. Dale reported they had taken 41 old coyotes out of the airplane since April 1st. Out of the ones he checked he took 51 unborn pups. One female he took had already had pups which he found and took the den. The litter sizes were looking to be 4-7 pups.

Operations and Personnel Committee: Bruegger reported that they did meet with the Thermal Contractors to discuss the contracts that we had offered them. The contractors had some things they wanted to amend to the contract before they would sign them.

Old Business

ADMB Grant: Boldon reported she turned in the grant and expected an email for the date of the interview any day.

Special Project Grant: Boldon reported she turned in the grant.

Thermal/Seasonal/Trouble Call Contractors: After discussion about the changes the contractors wanted to make to the Thermal Contracts. Boldon would amend the contract for those changes and York would have a special call to all the board members to approve that contract as Boldon amended it and offer it to the contractors before the May meeting.

Commissioners License: Boldon reported we needed to start advertising about this game tag we received and that she would post it on wyoga.com. Also, Richard Ladwig, Wyoming Game and Fish Commissioner, had been in contact with a board member and wanted to help the day we sell the tag.

New Business

Leasing Airplane Hangar: Boldon informed the board that she received a call from Travis Bruegger who was interested in renting the other half of the hangar since Dale was no longer going to rent it. Edwards moved to offer the lease to Travis Bruegger for the other half of the hangar. Motion was seconded. Motion carried with Shannon abstaining from voting.

Paying Gunners: York said she will check with Jerry on paying Gunners and tabled this till the next meeting.

Boldon presented bills from Kelly Huseby for March Aerial Services in the amount of \$6,000.00 and a bill from Shannon Bruegger for Aerial Services from January 29th through April 7th in the amount of \$8,430.00. Edwards moved to to pay Kelly for his Aerial Services in the amount of \$6,000.00 and pay Shannon for his Aerial Servcies in the amount of \$8,430.00. Motion was seconded. Motion carried.

At 6:00pm Kitson Boldon moved to go into executive session. Motion was seconded Motion carried.

At 6:02 pm the regular meeting went into executive session.

At 7:03 pm Lashmett moved to come out of executive session, and the regular meeting was resumed. Motion was seconded. Motion carried.




